We're starting today with UN SDG #1: No Poverty



Can you imagine how challenging daily life would be if you had to get by on less than \$3 a day?

For more than 800 million people worldwide, extreme poverty — living on under \$3 a day — is the harsh reality. This represents about **10% of the global population**. In fact, 80% of people living in extreme poverty are concentrated in sub-Saharan Africa and South Asia alone.

In Madagascar, around **3 out of every 4 people** live in extreme poverty with limited access to basic needs like food, education, healthcare, and stable income.

Our **Recruit & Restore** programs focus on long-term solutions to extreme poverty — creating jobs, protecting ecosystems, and empowering local communities to lead lasting change by strengthening both people and planet.



At Antsanitia, we partner with the local **Vondron'Olona Ifotony (VOI)** — a nationally-recognized, community-based association responsible for managing the local forests.

Once volunteer-led, the VOI can now offer paid opportunities that empower members to oversee planting, security, and long-term forest care activities.

By providing **work and income opportunities rooted in conservation**, your support creates improved livelihoods and increased household incomes for families around Antsanitia — and that's only the beginning.



Our recent team member surveys report positive changes in families':

- **Ability to meet food needs**
- **Access to health services**
- **Access to grade schools**
- **Access to clean water sources**
- **Ability to pay off debts and even to start micro-enterprises**

Plus, restoring mangrove forests re-creates vital habitats for marine life, protects vulnerable coastlines from extreme events — such as rising seas and flooding — and provides additional benefits from ecotourism and cultural services.
